The executive committee will have the power to deny membership or to suspend/ remove any person from membership. The removal, however, will be subject to the approval of general house by simple majority.A person shall cease to be a member of the association:<ol style="list-style-type: none">In the event of his/her death.After the acceptance of his/her resignation by the executive committee.After his/her expulsion from the association is approved by the general house.If he/she fails to pay the fee/dues within the specified period.Membership Fee: Every old student of the college, who wishes to be a member of this association, will have to pay Rs. 20 as life membership fee.

5.	Raising of the funds/capital of the association: i Life membership fee. ii Donations. iii Grants iv Souvenir Advertisements.
6.	Utilization of funds: i. A bank account in the name of the association shall be opened in a scheduled bank. All the funds collected from time to time shall be deposited in this account. The treasurer of the association shall maintain a detailed account of all receipts and payments of the funds of the association along with necessary vouchers etc. ii. The funds will be utilized on the advice of the Executive Committee/ general house and shall be operated by any two person from amongst the Patron, President, secretary and treasurer(One of the signatories must be patron) iii. The President or in his absence, the secretary shall be authorized to spend up to 5000/- at a given time against proper receipts/vouchers. The details of the expenditures shall be placed before the executive committee in the next meeting for approval. iv. The Secretary shall be authorized to keep an amount of the 500/- to meet contingent expenses. v. The Executive Committee shall be authorized to keep an amount of Rs. 500/- to meet contingent expenses. vi. The Executive Committee shall be authorized to spend up to 50,000/- for various activities of the association during one financial year. Any expenditure beyond this amount shall require the prior approval of the general house. vii. No office bearer/member of the Executive Committee shall be entitled to any remuneration out of this association fund.
7	Constitution of the Association: i General house shall comprise all members of the association. ii The Principal, Govt. College Sangrah shall be the Patron of the association. iii The Executive Committee of the association shall comprise the following 1 Patron 2 President 3 Vice President 4 Secretary 5 Joint Secretary 6 Treasure 7 Chief Advisor 8 Members(Maximum-6) iv Out of these Chief Advisor and one of the co-opted member will be from faculty of the college.
8	Election: a) The office bearers and the members of the executive committee shall be elected by the general house through consensus or majority with secret ballot. b) All the members of the general house shall be eligible to contest and vote except the defaulters covered under article 4(a) or (b) c) No proxy voting shall be allowed, d) A suspended or expelled members shall have no right to vote/contest the election.

9	Terms of Executive committee a) The elected office bearers and members of the committee shall have a term of two years or till the time new executive committee is elected by the general house .
10	Powers of the Executive Committee: a) Executive committee shall be the governing body of the association and shall have full powers to take any decision including framing of by-laws and other regulations b) No fund of the association can be spent/ utilized without the sanction of the executive committee unless provided in these rules
11	Duties of the office bearers i) President: He/ She shall be the chairman/ chairperson of the association and shall call and preside over the meeting of the general house and executive committee. ii) Vice President: In the absence of the President, Vice President shall preside over the meetings. iii) Secretary: Secretary shall execute the decision of the executive committee; He /She shall maintain the records of the proceedings of the meetings of the executives committees and the general house. He will maintain the properties of the association. He shall call the meetings of the executive committee and the general house on the advice of the President. iv) Joint Secretary: In the absence of the Secretary, the Joint Secretary shall assume the duties of the secretary. He will assist the secretary in the performance of his duties. v) Treasurer: He/ She will maintain the proper accounts of all receipts and payments of the associations. He shall get the accounts of the associations audited every year by the auditors appointed by the executive committee. He shall pay all the bills certified by the president and secretary. He shall maintain the register of the membership. In the event of the office of the treasurer falling vacant or long absence, the accounts will be operated by the secretary.
12	Audit: a) The executive committee shall every year nominate two persons to audit the accounts of the associations immediately after the completion of the financial year. b) The treasurer shall place the annual audit report in the annual meeting of the general house.
13	Meetings: a) Executive Committee i) Executive committee shall hold its meetings at least twice every year . The President can convene an emergency meeting by giving seven days notice to the members. ii) Any five members of the Executive committee can in writing, give requisition to the president to convene a special meeting of the executive committee and the President shall be bound to convene such a meeting with in fifteen days from the date of requisition failing which such meeting shall be convened by the vice president or the secretary. iii) The decisions shall be arrived at by the majority vote. The president shall exercise his casting vote in case of tie. b) The president shall convene meeting of the general house every year.
